Scenario 1

Scenario 2

One of the party-goers needs to get home quickly because their parents called and found out they weren't where they said they would be. John offers to drive as he only lives in the next suburb and he hasn't been drinking or taking drugs that night. Should he? What are the risks?

Scenario 3

There was a huge mix-up and several people have been left with no way of getting home from the party. Some people have managed to get a lift home and are just about to leave the party when they see someone getting into a car with Sarah. It looks like Sarah is planning to drive – what could be done?

Scenario 4

Sam has spent most of the party with his new girlfriend and has offered to take her to another party that he knows about. He tells her that he is fine to drive as he hasn't been drinking. Should she go with him? What are the potential risks? What could be said to her to convince her not to get into the car?
