# Activity 3 What's the risk?

## RISK FACTOR

### Wheels

Riding a bicycle without holding on to the handlebars.

### Wheels

Learning to rollerblade on steep or uneven surfaces.

## RISK FACTOR

### Wheels

Overtaking a parked car on a bicycle.

## RISK FACTOR

### Pedestrian

Stepping straight onto a pedestrian crossing without looking.

## RISK FACTOR

### Pedestrian

Walking alone at night.

## RISK FACTOR

### Wheels

A bicycle rider in a line of traffic intending to turn right at an intersection.

## RISK FACTOR

### Wheels

Wearing dark coloured clothes while riding or skateboarding

## RISK FACTOR

### Wheels

Riding a bicycle or skateboard, listening to music with headphones on.

## RISK FACTOR

### Wheels

Giving a person a "double" on a bicycle.

## RISK FACTOR

### Pedestrian

Wearing dark coloured clothing when walking.

## RISK FACTOR

### Pedestrian

Walking with a group of 3 to 5 friends during the day.

## RISK FACTOR

### Pedestrian

Walking and listening to music with headphones on.

## RISK FACTOR

### Pedestrian

Having the attitude that nothing can happen to me, "I can handle any situation."

## RISK FACTOR

### Passenger

Travelling in a car with loud music.

## RISK FACTOR

### Passenger

Being a passenger in a car with a driver who is keen to impress his or her friends.

## RISK FACTOR

### Pedestrian

Crossing a wide and busy city street, where there are parked cars, buses and multiple lanes.

## RISK FACTOR

### Pedestrian

Crossing the traffic lights when the "red person" is flashing.

### Pedestrian

Running or walking along the edge of the road in the same direction as the traffic flow.

Being in a hurry to get to the shops.

Being a passenger in a car with a parent who has consumed two glasses of wine in the last hour.
